



MAKE YOUR OWN CORK HAT

Your task is to find your top 8 Australian Celebrities and write them in the stars on page 2 & 3. Then, follow the instructions below to make your own Aussie Celebrity Cork Hat!

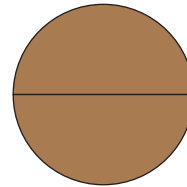
You'll need:

These pages printed on A4 paper
Scissors
Glue
Hole Punch
String
Pencils



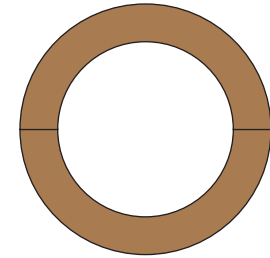
Step 1

Cut out all hat and star shapes, including the yellow glue tabs.



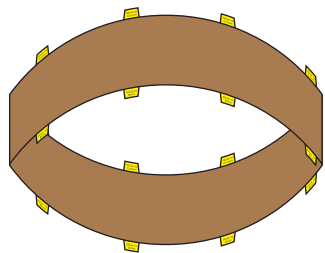
Step 2

Glue crown halves together



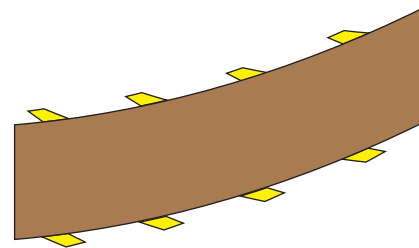
Step 3

Glue brim halves together



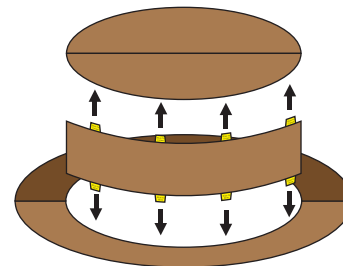
Step 4

Glue hat height 1 and 2 together so you get a complete loop



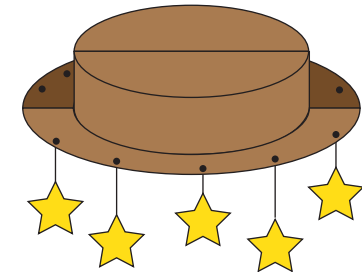
Step 5

Bend Hat Height yellow tabs so crown tabs are 90 degrees back and brim tabs are 90 degree forward.



Step 6

Glue the top yellow tabs on the combined Hat Height loop to the bottom of the crown and the bottom yellow tabs under the brim.

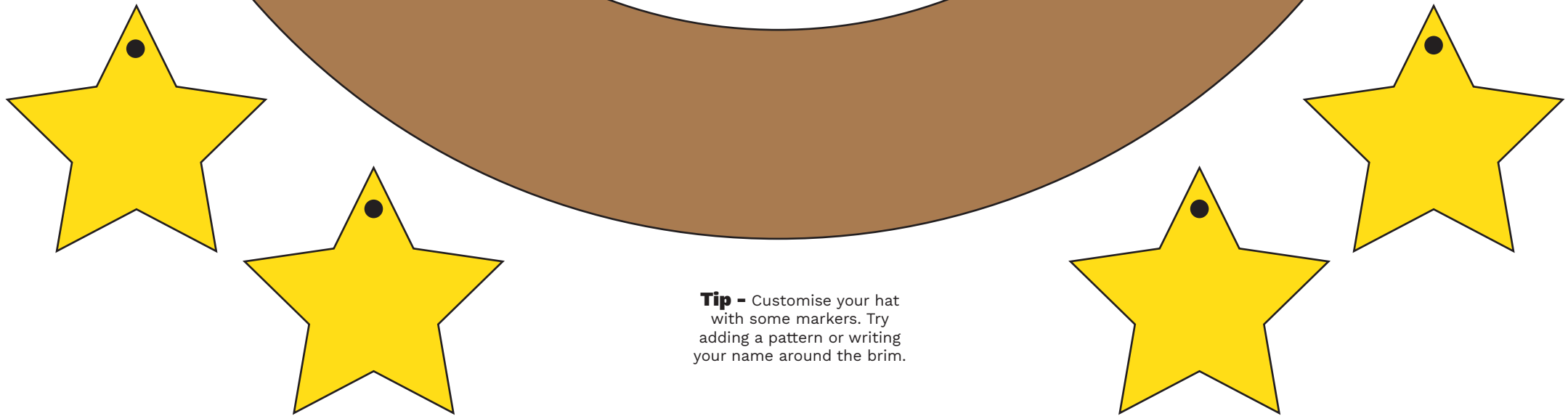


Step 7

Punch 8 holes around the outside of the brim. The punch holes in the stars and tie them to the hat through the holes. Tip: use a pen or sharp pencil if you don't have a hole punch.

Crown 1

Tip - Cut just inside the black line if you don't want black borders on your final hat



Tip - Customise your hat with some markers. Try adding a pattern or writing your name around the brim.

Crown 2

Glue to other half of crown

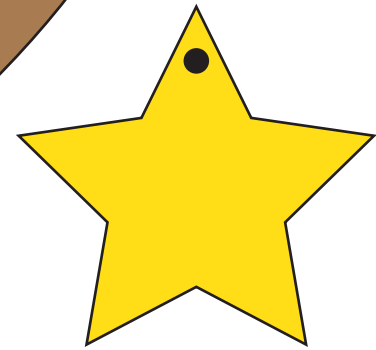

Tip - Use thicker paper to make your hat stronger, or re-enforce the crown or brim by gluing some paddle pop sticks underneath.

Tip - Cut just inside the black line if you don't want black borders on your final hat

Tip - You can play around with the height of your hat with these pieces. Make it shorter by cutting these sections differently. Or perhaps use different coloured paper or cardboard to make it really tall, just remember to add glue tabs onto your cut-outs.
