Before visiting Madame Tussaud's, discuss the ideas below and try taking pictures at school or at home.

When experimenting try: (examples included later on)

- Shooting from different perspectives Up high, down low
- Getting in close stepping back for a wider angle shot moving around your subject to shoot from different sides.
- Experimenting with different settings (different exposure modes)
- Have you got the best shot? Do you want a full body shot, a half body shot or a head shot? Which will work best?

Extension for Portrait Photography

Capturing peoples' moods and expressions is an intriguing subject for photographers. They can be close-up images, body portraits etc.

Usually, the face is the focus of this type of photography. While taking a portrait, the photographer should ensure that the subject's face is:

- sharp and focused, especially his or her eyes.
- The subject's pose should also be flattering. To capture a person's natural expressions, the photographer should lighten the mood by cracking a joke or two.


